The Marine Corps League's 'Aloha' Detachment #363, located on Oahu, Hawaii, was reactivated in 2008 and formally chartered on May 1, 2009. Proceeds from tournament will go to programs authorized by the Detachment membership. One program is for high school seniors enrolled in a Marine or Navy Junior ROTC program on Oahu; a dependent of a Marine or Sailor stationed with Marine Corps Base Hawaii or Camp Smith; a dependent of a retired Marine or Sailor employed aboard Marine Corps Base Hawaii or Camp Smith; a dependent of a member in the MCL Aloha Detachment.

Since its inception in 2009, the Detachment has been making a positive difference in the academic lives of qualified local students by awarding over \$100,000 in scholarships.

The noblest part of the Marine Corps League's mission is honoring those Marines who paid the 'ultimate price' while defending our Nation in war.

During the surprise attack on Pearl Harbor, 73 Marines died aboard the U.S.S. Arizona while engaged in that task. To honor and remember these men and the 15 others who survived the attack, a memorial was established by the National Park Service in 2005. The Detachment is charged with maintaining the site.

We support organizations such as Navy and Marine Corps ROTC programs, Pyramid Rock Young Marines and Boy Scouts.
